What is a cottage country? In simple terms, a cottage country refers to a popular location for vacationers to rent a cottage or summer house.


These areas are typically settled in a quaint location near a body of water and include many activities such as boating, hiking, or simply relaxing at the beach or crowding around the fire.



popular for local fishermen and is
considered by many to be the best
game fish in Ontario.


